William Booth (1829-1912) Leader of an Army, Follower of Christ Matthew 28:18-20 from Walk Thru The Bible Indeed devotional

Sixty years of ministry; five million miles of travel; sixty thousand sermons preached; two million soldiers of Christ's army recruited, trained, and deployed in strategic positions around the world. Indeed, William Booth, the founder and first general of the Salvation Army, served God faithfully and fruitfully.

All around you are people in need, both spiritually and physically. What can you do to meet them at their point of need? Share the gospel, to be sure; pray for them, by all means; but don't stop there. Follow the example of William Booth, who made it a habit never to send anyone away with merely a nod and a prayer. A lesson from the life of William Booth: Meeting people at their point of physical need opens the door for the gospel.
