## **HEIDELBERG CATECHISM LORD'S DAY 8**

24. Q. How are these articles divided?

A. Into three parts: the first is about God the Father and our creation; the second about God the Son and our redemption; the third about God the Holy Spirit and our sanctification.

25. Q. Since there is only one God, why do we speak of three persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit?

A Because God has so revealed himself in the word that these three distinct persons are the one, true, eternal God.
